

Towards New Doctoral Studies Model in Latvia

Factor	Current Model	New Model
Income	State scholarship (€114 per month). Salaries vary significantly.	A portion of the salary is funded by the government (€1,000 per month).
Employment	Depends on the availability of funding and other factors.	Mandatory (at least 0.8 FTE).
Beginning of Studies	The beginning of the academic year (September/October).	Not synchronized with the beginning of the academic year.
Organization and Standards	Separate and different for each university.	The establishment of a unified PhD program and the standardization of its requirements.

Towards New Academic Career Framework in Latvia

Factor	Current Model	New Model
Career Path	The unpredictability stemming from short-term contracts and inconsistent regulations.	Tenure-track with permanent positions and clear requirements.
Income	Primarily funded through short-term research projects. The compensation for teaching is low.	Guaranteed salary at tenure position with motivational bonus system.
Research and Teaching	Research and teaching careers are structurally unintegrated (the result of a <i>dual legislation</i>).	All academics both teach and conduct research (the proportion differs).
